<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Berthing and operations – No delays for cargo operations and RO-RO services connecting mainland and islands are back in operation. • Surveyors boarding - Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. • Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – Whilst air connections with Athens offer gradually increasing options, the situation is still difficult and mandatory 14-day quarantine for all nationalities is still in force until 15th June. • Provision of medical services – Unobstructed at private hospitals. 	<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Berthing and operations – No significant delays with the exception of some delays on account of queued-up medico-sanitary inspections and pilots boarding. • Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. Boarding at roads for ship’s in transit is also allowed as of 1st June. • Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – possible for Turkish citizens and very restricted for foreign nationals due to the unavailability of flights. As of 10th June, Turkish Airlines is to gradually resume international flights. • Provision of medical services – disembarkation allowed for serious/urgent complaints after preliminary assessment on board. Crew is not subjected to PCR confirmation of non-infection and examinations/treatment are carried out at private hospitals. • Curfew and intercity travel restrictions apply.

<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Berthing and operations – No delays. • Surveyors boarding - Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. • Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – Difficult given travel limitations but less restricted for EU nationals as some of the measures are being relaxed and flying to hub airports is reintroduced. • Provision of medical services – Current ban on planned/non-urgent surgeries leads to some delay (24-48hrs) in handling of borderline cases and a negative PCR test is requested. Urgent work or crewmembers delivered through Emergency services are handled as usual. 	<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Berthing and operations – Generally no delays though some shortage of port personnel • Surveyors boarding – In Constantza, allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. In Galatz port local authorities forbid access to ship’s through port area and attendances are arranged by boats • Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – Difficult given travel limitations but less restricted for EU nationals as some of the measures are being relaxed. • Provision of medical services – Unobstructed and no distinction between urgent and non-urgent cases.

<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Berthing and operations – No delays.• Surveyors boarding - Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures.• Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – Relatively extensive travel options when compared with other countries. Egypt maintains flights to some European, neighbouring Arab and Far East countries.• Provision of medical services – Unobstructed.• Curfew further extended till mid June.	<p>Highlights as at 01.06.2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Berthing and operations – No delays• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures.• Crew changes and repatriation of ill/injured/dead – Difficult given travel limitations but unobstructed by local orders (only subjected to testing or med certificate of a recent test).• Provision of medical services – Unobstructed.
