<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No delays for cargo operations. RO-RO services connecting mainland and islands operate a reduced winter service.</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. Some private terminals and vessels require submission of health declaration forms and/or recent negative PCR test results prior to granting access.</li> <li>• Crew changes/ repatriations are possible with the following to apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- On-signers: No entry to Greece allowed for non-EU/non-Schengen citizens with some exceptions to apply. Compulsory submission of 72-hour negative PCR test and 24-hour PLF form for all nationalities. 7 days compulsory quarantine applicable on arrival (regardless of a negative PCR test)</li> <li>- Off-signers: No PCR test entry requirement for EU citizens – however negative PCR test may be required depending on their destination. 72-hour negative PCR requirement for entry and departure of third countries citizens.</li> <li>- Shore passes not granted/ not allowed.</li> <li>- No requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Provision of medical services – Unobstructed at private hospitals. Public hospitals are heavily occupied with COVID-19 patients. Strict visiting restrictions in place.</li> <li>• Night curfew and intercity travel restrictions apply.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No significant delays except for some on account of queued up sanitary inspections and pilots boarding.</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Subject to provision of a HES code established by The Government of Turkey. Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures. Some facilities require submission of health medical form to allow entry and on some occasions, additional permission from local authorities. Some Owners require negative COVID-19 test results of 48 hours before permitting on board attendance.</li> <li>• Crew changes/ repatriations are possible with the following to apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Entry to Turkey subject to medical screening on arrival. Seafarers have key worker status are excluded from the below requirements, which are applied for all passengers, who on arrival to Turkey from abroad have to present a negative COVID-19 test made not earlier than 72hours before arrival.</li> <li>- PCR test mandatory if required by destination country/airline.</li> <li>- Commercial flights are gradually resuming on country by country basis. Arrivals to Turkey from Brazil, the United Kingdom, Denmark, and South Africa are suspended.</li> <li>- No Requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19 applied in Turkey yet.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

For transit vessels, disembarkation allowed only for urgent/serious cases, decided on case by case basis. State hospitals are congested with COVID-19 patients and generally accept only urgent cases, otherwise care in private hospitals is recommended.</li><li>• Curfew is in force for Turkish citizens only.</li></ul> |

Bulgaria	Romania
<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No delays</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures</li> <li>• Crew changes/ repatriations – Difficult given travel limitations but less restricted for EU nationals</li> <li>• Provision of medical services – Negative PCR test is a prerequisite. Urgent cases are handled as usual. Some delay (24-48 hours) on planned/ non-urgent surgeries.</li> <li>• No requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19 applicable yet</li> </ul>	<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No delays generally.</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing. Avoiding contact with crew on board is widely recommended.</li> <li>• Crew changes/ repatriations are possible with the following to apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No PCR test entry requirement for crew to enter Romania or sign on board by Authorities. However, most Ship Owners request negative PCR test for health reasons during crew change.</li> <li>- For repatriations, PCR test not older than 48-72 hours if required by destination country/airline.</li> <li>- Isolation or quarantine is not required by authorities for crew changes, however, the measure is practiced depending on the hiring company’s policy;</li> <li>- Shore passes not officially forbidden but leaving the vessel is generally prevented by local policy due to given conditions.</li> <li>- Requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19 not applicable as yet</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Provision of medical services – Unobstructed and no distinction between urgent and non-urgent cases</li> <li>• Curfew and intercity travel restrictions apply only during nighttime, with exceptions such as work purposes, medical assistance, etc.</li> <li>• Various terrestrial borders are closed and flights to/from countries on the red zone list are suspended.</li> </ul>

Egypt	Cyprus
<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No delays</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE and distancing measures</li> <li>• Crew changes/repatriations are possible with the following to apply:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Both sign-on/ off and entry to Egypt for all nationalities including Egyptians is permitted only with submission of negative PCR test results of 72hours on arrival. Quarantine doctors will board vessels at Port Said(SB) and Suez(NB) anchorage to collect samples.</li> <li>- Commercial flights operate normally to most destinations, regardless it is advisable to check restrictions per destination (e.g. China)</li> <li>- No requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Provision of medical services – Response decided on case by case basis according to severity and vessel’s position after initial assessment by a visiting doctor on board</li> </ul>	<p><b>Highlights as at 17.02.2021</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Berthing and operations – No delays to commercial operations. Boarding/ disembarking of cruise ship passengers forbidden.</li> <li>• Surveyors boarding – Allowed with observance of PPE, distancing measures and COVID-19 negative rapid test</li> <li>• Crew changes/ repatriations are possible with the following to apply:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Compulsory negative PCR test to enter and leave the country</li> <li>- Permission from Shipping Deputy Ministry and Cyprus flight pass</li> <li>- No shore passes allowed</li> <li>- No requirement for seafarer’s obligatory vaccination against COVID-19</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Provision of medical services – Case response decided based on initial onboard assessment by State appointed doctor. Visits to public and private hospitals prohibited.</li> <li>• Night curfew restrictions apply.</li> </ul>
